It is a requirement of the Health & Safety law that employers provide a safe & healthy environment to work in. If your assessment of First Aid needs highlights the need for qualified first aiders, then this level 3 qualification (Level 6 in Scotland) will provide you with suitable, highly trained personnel.

This comprehensive three-day course covers a wide range of First Aid Emergencies, enabling all participants to deal with emergency situations with confidence in prompt, safe & effective way. In addition, this course will include any protocol changes that may have risen since their last training course.

This course will give the participants a qualification to the highest level of First Aid, meeting the statutory requirements of the Health & Safety (First Aid) Regulations 1981.

Duration

A Minimum of 18hours spread over at least 3 days. Ideally, the course should be run over three consecutive days, but we have the flexibility to accommodate your specific needs if you so desire providing it is completed within 10 weeks of starting the course & the training sessions last for a minimum of two hours.

Certification

Summative practical assessment is ongoing by the instructor each day, along with a written assessment on each day. A three year Level 3 Award in First Aid at Work (Level 6 in Scotland) will be issued to the learner, subject to successful assessment. No External assessors are required.

Numbers

A maximum of 12 Students are allowed with a minimum of 14 years of age & a certificate can be offered to all, subject to assessment. A student cannot assume a responsibility in the workplace until they reach the age of 16, & then it is the employer's responsibility to ensure that the student is suitable for that role.

The Certificate will expire as dated on the Certificate, respective of age.
